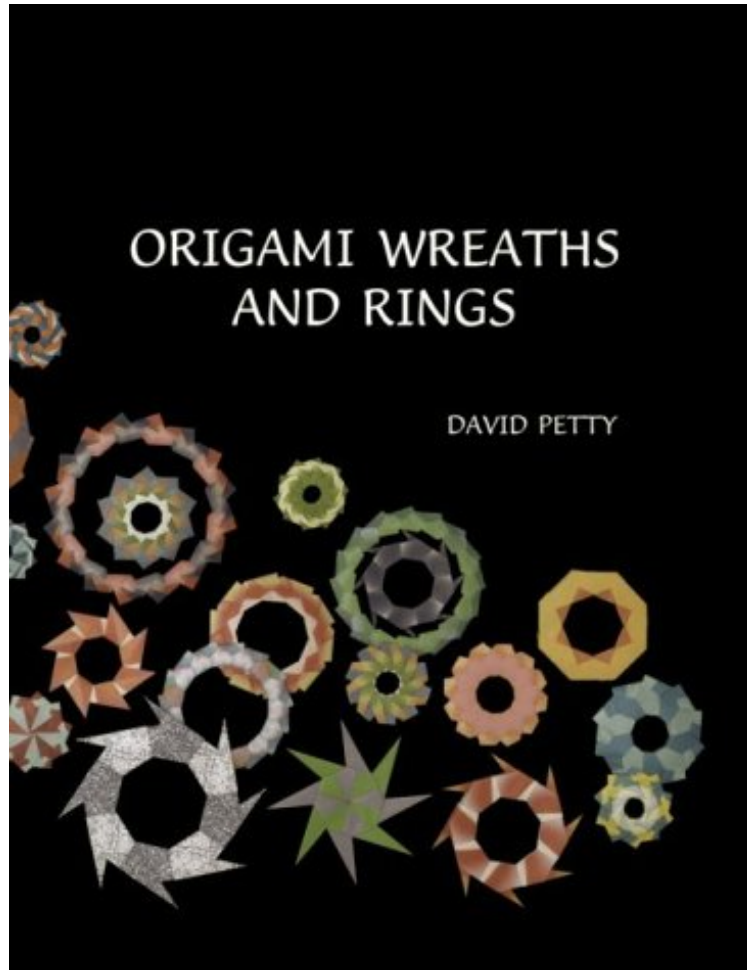

And of course his website is still up in his memory, as he died 3-4-5 (?) years ago. Origami Wreaths and Rings has an abundance of designs for rings, wreaths, brooches, garlands, motifs, and you can mix and match as you please. The directions and drawings are excellent and easy to follow -- well, he says it is for low-intermediate folders and that sure fits me! No color pictures except on front and back cover, but that's okay, just open up your supply of paper and start creating. Sometimes when I

get a new origami book I'm a little bit disappointed that some of the models will probably always be way beyond me. Not so in this case. I love modular and the challenge of putting all those pieces together, and as I said, Mr. Petty's directions are very good. I bought this "second-hand", and so a word about the supplier -- something like amictj -- they said the book was in new condition and so it is; it arrived in pristine shape and earlier than I expected. By HS Lim Do not be put off by the name of the book or the word "wreath". How about words like "brooches", "garlands", "motifs", "rings"? How about "frisbee"? I recommend this book for its simplicity. You need to learn to fold one unit from a selected model. Fold the same unit several times and join it to form a ring. Because of this repetition, it serves as good practice for a beginner or for children. It is good to get a group of children together and each one fold the same unit and with together form a beautiful ring. This is real team work! Repeated folding also encourages mastery and this mastery is useful when you learn to fold other origami models later. There are many beautiful rings and with the right colour, it is very attractive and eye catching. This goes well as part of a greeting card. I had enjoyed folding many of the models within and used it as part of my origami display.
